

STAGEZONE YOUTH THEATRE – COVID POLICY – AS AT 01.03.2022

- A new Stagezone Registration Form will need to be completed for all students prior to the first session.
- Parents will not be permitted to stay inside the hall during sessions.
- Each session will last 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- All students will be asked to use hand gel upon entering and leaving the session.
- Students may arrive wearing masks and wear them during the sessions, although there is currently no mandatory requirement for people to wear masks. It will therefore be up to individual students/families to decide to wear or not wear masks at Stagezone sessions.
- Students may bring 1 water bottle, which remains the responsibility of the student and must be placed underneath the chair of the student. No drink will be provided by Stagezone Youth Theatre.
- Students will be asked to wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, and to use hand gel after visiting the toilet.
- If any student is displaying Covid type symptoms during a session, the student will be isolated in a designated area at the venue and a telephone call made to the parents to collect the student immediately.
- If any student or member of their family is displaying Covid symptoms, please do not attend Stagezone sessions, and follow the current Government requirements and advice. The venue will be informed if a student of Stagezone has recently attended the venue and has a confirmed case of Covid.
- If any student and family has visited another country and been required to self-isolate, please notify Stagezone youth Theatre and do not attend Stagezone sessions until safe to do so, following current Government guidelines.
- All chairs/tables used will be wiped with antibacterial spray/wipes after use.
- Windows will be opened at each venue in order to increase ventilation.
- If collaborative group work is carried out, students will be asked to use hand gel before and after each group session.
